Green Globes® Certification program provides customized guidance in the design, construction and operation of high-performance commercial, institutional and high-rise multifamily residential buildings, both public and private. It is a commercial building rating system that is an American National Standard (ANSI).

Green Globes® NC program utilizes weighted criteria in its assessment protocol, assessing building environmental impacts on a 1,000-point scale across seven categories. Each of these categories has an assigned number of points that quantify overall building performance.

Prerequisites and Credits in the Green Globes® NC System address the following Categories:

- Project Management (PM)
- Site (S)
- Energy (E)
- Water (W)
- Materials & Resources (MR)
- Emissions (E)
- Indoor Environment (IE)
