This project includes the assessment and verification of the inventory GHG emissions reported by Owens Corning for all Scope 1 and 2 emissions, as well as all reported categories for Scope 3 emissions as calculated using EIO-LCA software and other methods.

- Evaluate to a limited level of assurance whether Owens Corning has completely and accurately measured and reported their total scope 3 emissions, have reported all applicable data of emissions sources, and have correctly utilized the EIO-LCA software to report their Scope 3 data.
